## **Mission of Department**

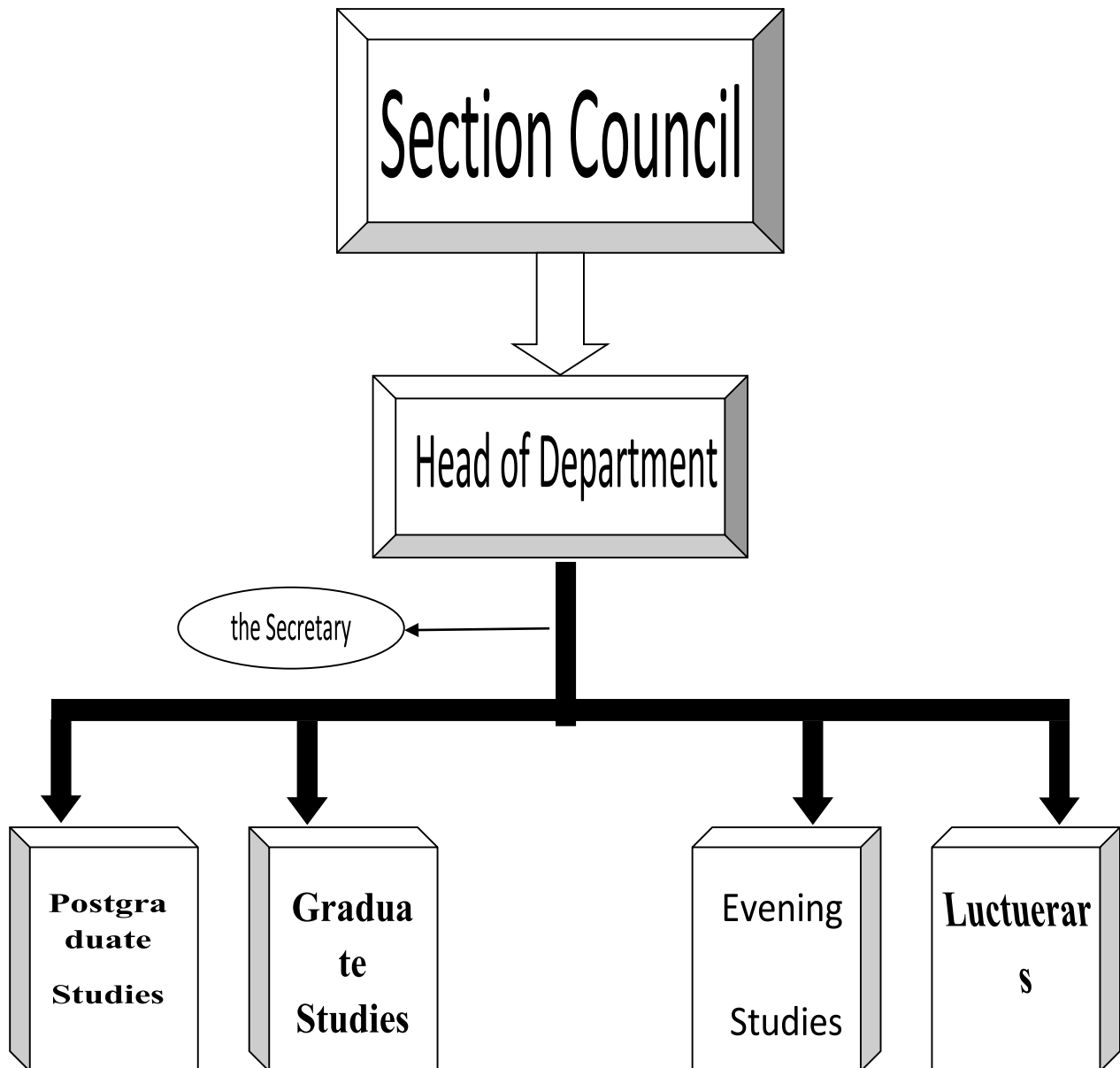


